5 Relating to the location of the
6 headquarters of the Alaska Com-
7 munications System.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Alaska Communications System, U.S. Air Force, has
10 provided the Territory and State of Alaska and its people its
11 basic communications service for decades; and

12 WHEREAS this service is intended to provide military and
13 public communication within Alaska and to link the internal system
14 with the national communication systems; and

15 WHEREAS the headquarters for this Alaska-based and Alaska-
16 oriented system is located at Seattle, Washington; and

17 WHEREAS the headquarters of the Alaska Communication System
18 ought to be in the area in which it is operated and serves;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Alaska Delegation in
20 Congress are urged to move for the necessary action to move the
21 headquarters of the Alaska Communications System from Seattle,
22 Washington to Anchorage, Alaska; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the
24 Honorable Robert S. McNamara, Secretary of Defense; the Honorable
25 Eugene M. Zuckert, Secretary of the Air Force; Major General James
26 C. Jensen, Commander, Alaskan Air Command; and the members of the
27 Alaska Delegation in Congress.
