5 Relating to the promulgation of
6 a rule relating to the qualifica-
7 tions of guides by the Board of
8 Fish and Game.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

10 WHEREAS, it is of great importance to maintain a high level
11 of competence and responsibility among the guides of the state;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, experience under competent supervision has been
14 found to be extremely important in assuring this competency and
15 responsibility; and

16 WHEREAS, there is now no supervised experience requirement in
17 the rules of the Board of Fish and Game relating to guides;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fish and Game is advised
19 that it is the wish of the House of Representatives that a regula-
20 tion be promulgated to amend sec. 403.01 of Title 5 of the Alaska
21 Administrative Code to require that in addition to the other
22 qualifications, a candidate for a license as registered guide must
23 have two years of experience as an assistant guide or 5 years
24 hunting experience in Alaska, unless he has previously held a full
25 guide license under either the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service or
26 the Alaska Department of Fish and Game.
