BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS, the burden of state government is large enough

ways to rely, when feasible, on private industry to accomplish

the construction and other work necessary to the development and

maintenance of the Alaska highway system; and

WHEREAS, such a course of action would benefit the state by

encouraging the expansion of private industry and by reducing

18

the state payroll;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully urged to

20

direct the Department of Highways to perform only those functions

21

for which it is peculiarly suited and to rely on private industry

in all other areas.
