5 Relating to a bridge structure study

6 for the proposed Knik Arm Crossing.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the extension of transportation and communication
9 systems is vital for the sound development of Alaska and its re-
10 sources; and

11 WHEREAS the construction of the Knik Arm Crossing would pro-
12 vide the citizens of the greater Anchorage and Susitna Valley
13 areas with better means of transportation and communication; and

14 WHEREAS the Susitna Valley, a land of scenic beauty and vast
15 agricultural, mineral, and residential potential would be made
16 accessible for development; and

17 WHEREAS before building the Knik Arm Crossing it is necessary
18 to determine the best location and type of bridge structure for
19 taking this important step forward in the development of Alaska's
20 highway system;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully urged to
22 direct the Department of Highways to make the reconnaissance, and
23 engineering and economic feasibility surveys necessary to deter-
24 mine the location and type of bridge structure best suited for
25 crossing Knik Arm.
