2 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 13

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the building of a  
6 seawall at Point Hope to protect  
7 the underground storage areas.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

9 WHEREAS storms approaching from the north and west cause  
10 high seas which jeopardize the general welfare of the inhabitants  
11 of Point Hope; and

12 WHEREAS most of the valuable storage areas of Point Hope  
13 are located in underground areas on the north side of Point Hope;  
14 and

15 WHEREAS high seas have caused considerable damage to these  
16 valuable storage areas during storms; and

17 WHEREAS a seawall built on the north side of Point Hope would  
18 deflect the high seas and prevent further damage being done to  
19 these storage areas;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, United States  
21 Army, is respectfully urged to construct the necessary seawall  
22 at Point Hope designed to protect these storage areas and the  
23 general welfare of its inhabitants; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
25 the Honorable Cyrus R. Vance, Secretary of the Army; the Honor-  
26 able Charles Buckley, Chairman, House Committee on Public Works  
27 and Labor; the Honorable Pat McNamara, Chairman, Senate Committee  
28 on Public Works; Lt. General W. K. Wilson, Jr., Chief of Engin-  
29 eers, United States Army; Col. Kenneth T. Sawyer, District

1 Engineer, Corps of Engineers, United States Army; and the members  
2 of the Alaska Delegation in Congress.
