3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the building of a
6 seawall at Kotzebue.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the city of Kotzebue is located on federal land and
9 federal installations are located there; and

10 WHEREAS Kotzebue is located in an area where there is little
11 protection against the sea in the event of severe storms, which
12 have, in the past, inflicted severe damage; and

13 WHEREAS the existing seawall at Kotzebue was damaged so
14 severely in the last storm that it is completely useless at this
15 time; and

16 WHEREAS life and property will remain in extreme danger
17 from storms until Kotzebue is adequately protected by a new sea-
18 wall;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Corps of Engineers, United States
20 Army is respectfully urged to construct the necessary seawall at
21 Kotzebue, designed to protect the lives and property of the people
22 living there; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
24 the Honorable Cyrus R. Vance, Secretary of the Army; the Honorable
25 Charles Buckley, Chairman, House Committee on Public Works and
26 Labor; the Honorable Pat McNamara, Chairman, Senate Committee on
27 Public Works; Lt. General W. K. Wilson, Jr., Chief of Engineers,
28 United States Army; Col. Kenneth T. Sawyer, District Engineer,
29 Corps of Engineers, United States Army; and the members of the
