5 Relating to hearings on certain bills  
6 relating to coin-operated gambling  
7 devices and other machines and mechanical  
8 devices.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

10 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives now has before it House  
11 Bill 229, relating to coin-operated gambling devices, and Senate  
12 Bill No. 179, relating to the maintenance and operation of certain  
13 machines and mechanical devices; and

14 WHEREAS, hundreds of telegrams have been received in the  
15 House of Representatives concerning these bills; and

16 WHEREAS, it is clear that the subject matter is one of great  
17 interest and import to many Alaskans; and

18 WHEREAS, before taking action which embodies a major policy  
19 decision on these matters, the Legislature wishes to encourage the  
20 expression of views by all the people of the state;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hold hearings on  
22 House Bill No. 229 and Senate Bill No. 179 in Anchorage, Fairbanks,  
23 and Juneau, and in such other places in the state as it determines  
24 are appropriate, and that it report its findings and conclusions,  
25 together with any recommendations which it may have to the Second  
26 Session of the Third Legislature in January 1964.
