3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a survey by state agencies of
6 the potential value for state facilities
7 of the installation at the Port of
8 Whittier, Alaska.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

10 WHEREAS, the United States Army intends to declare most of
11 the facilities at the Port of Whittier, Alaska, excess to its
12 needs and turn it over to the General Services Administration for
13 other use or disposal; and

14 WHEREAS, the state will probably have an opportunity to
15 obtain this costly complex of facilities for a price far below
16 replacement cost; and

17 WHEREAS, several state agencies are considering the
18 acquisition of facilities to carry out state programs; and

19 WHEREAS, the state might be able to effect a very significant
20 saving of money by acquiring the facilities of the Port of Whittier
21 for its purposes;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor direct the various agencies
23 of the state which may need such facilities to survey the Whittier
24 facilities for adequacy and appropriateness for their respective
25 programs and to submit a report on their findings to the Second
26 Session of the Third Legislature.
