9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

10 WHEREAS, Governor William A. Egan of the State of Alaska, in
11 his "State of the State" address to the Joint Assembly of this
12 Legislature on January 28, 1964, declared unemployment to be
13 Alaska's greatest immediate problem; and

14 WHEREAS, Governor Egan urged this session of the Legislature
15 to "firmly and forcefully direct itself toward achieving solu-
16 tions for a number of problems related to employment"; and

17 WHEREAS, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, on
18 January 31, 1964, appointed a bi-partisan Special Committee to
19 Study the Problem of Acute Unemployment in Alaska;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Special Committee is directed to
21 investigate the problem of unemployment in Alaska by gathering
22 facts and hearing testimony pertinent to this field of inquiry;
23 and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Special Committee, consisting of
25 Messrs. Wiggins (Chairman), Gravel, Cashel, Christiansen,
26 Leonard, Holm, and Sullivan, is directed to report its findings
27 to the House of Representatives not later than March 4, 1964.
