3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the scope and functions of
6 the Special Committee to Study the Prob-
7 lem of Acute Unemployment in Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

9 WHEREAS, Governor William A. Egan of the State of Alaska, in
10 his "State of the State" address to the Joint Assembly of this
11 Legislature on January 28, 1964, declared unemployment to be
12 Alaska's greatest immediate problem; and

13 WHEREAS, Governor Egan urged this session of the Legislature
14 to "firmly and forcefully direct itself toward achieving solutions
15 for a number of problems related to employment";

16 BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby created a special bi-
17 partisan committee composed of four Democrats chosen by the
18 Democratic members of the House and four Republicans chosen by the
19 Republican members of the House, with due regard given to area
20 representation so that no more than one Democrat and one Republi-
21 can is appointed from the same election district; the committee
22 shall choose its chairman from its membership and keep a record of
23 its proceedings; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the special committee is directed to
25 investigate the problem of unemployment in Alaska by gathering
26 facts and hearing testimony pertinent to this field of inquiry in
27 the same manner and with the same powers as those of a standing
28 committee of the House; and be it

29 FURTHER RESOLVED that the special committee is directed to

1 report its findings to the House of Representatives not later
2 than March 4, 1964.
