3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 THIRD LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the federal cost-of-
6 living allowance in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS, legislation is now before Congress which would
9 eliminate the cost-of-living allowance for classified federal
10 employees in Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS, H.R. 7401 would replace the allowance with salary
12 adjustments which supposedly would make the salaries comparable
13 to those paid by industry in the state; and

14 WHEREAS, the absence of an industrial economy in Alaska and
15 uncertainty as to the effect of the proposal on take-home pay
16 strongly suggests the need for further study of the legislation;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the subcommittee of the House Committee
18 on Post Office and Civil Service is respectfully requested to
19 give H.R. 7401 exhaustive study, with hearings in Alaska, to
20 determine its actual impact on the classified federal employees
21 in Alaska; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
23 the Honorable Tom Murray, Chairman, House Committee on Post
24 Office and Civil Service; the Honorable Morris K. Udall, Chairman
25 of the Subcommittee on the Cost-of-Living Allowance; the Honorable
26 Olin D. Johnston, Chairman, Senate Post Office and Civil Service
27 Committee; and the members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
