7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS, an outstanding Alaskan, Mildred R. Hermann, has been
9 taken in death; and

10 WHEREAS, the late Mildred R. Hermann is identified in the
11 minds and hearts of many Alaskans as an active citizen dedicated
12 to and working for the public good; and

13 WHEREAS, her record of public service was highlighted by her
14 leadership in the Alaska statehood movement as secretary to the
15 Alaska Statehood Committee and as a delegate to the Alaska Consti-
16 tutional Convention; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition to her dedicated public service as a
18 participant in and observer of the public affairs of the territory
19 and state, Mrs. Hermann established a commendable record as an
20 attorney who devoted much of her time to legal work for the less
21 fortunate; and

22 WHEREAS, her zest for work and accomplishment found her a
23 leader in the activities of the Alaska Cancer Society, the Alaska
24 Tuberculosis Association, the Heart Association, and other organi-
25 zations dedicated to active programs for the betterment of society,
26 and her community and state;

27 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives does hereby
28 express its profound sadness at the passing of Mildred R. Hermann,
29 an outstanding citizen and friend of Alaska and all it aspires to,

1 and commends to the attention of all Alaskans her forthrightness,
2 honesty, and diligence as a public and private citizen as a model
3 of good and effective citizenship. The House of Representatives
4 hereby expresses its sincerest condolences to her family at this
5 time of loss and grief.
