IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to claims against property of the blind."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.25.710 is amended to read:

Sec. 47.25.710. ALIENATION AND ATTACHMENT. Assistance granted under secs. 620 - 780 of this chapter is inalienable by assignment or transfer and is exempt from garnishment, levy, or execution under the laws of the state. In case of bankruptcy the aid does not pass through a trustee or other person acting on behalf of creditors.

* Sec. 2. AS 47.25.720 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 47.25.720. EXEMPTION FROM LIENS. No claim or lien against any property of a recipient of aid under secs. 620 - 780 of this chapter arises in favor of the state at the time of the giving of the aid as a result of the giving of the aid. However, upon the death of the recipient, the state may assert a claim against the estate as a general creditor for the amount of aid given.
