6 For an Act entitled: "An Act enlarging the membership of the
7 Board of Fish and Game; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.220 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 16.05.220. THE BOARD OF FISH AND GAME. There is
12 created a Board of Fish and Game composed of 11 [10] members
13 having a general knowledge of the fish and game resources
14 of the state and selected without regard to political
15 affiliation or special interest. Each member of the board
16 shall be a United States citizen and a resident of the
17 state. Members of the board are appointed by the governor,
18 subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the
19 legislature in joint session.

20 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.230 is amended to read:

21 Sec. 16.05.230. TERM OF OFFICE. The term of office
22 for members of the board is four years. The first members
23 appointed serve as follows: two members shall serve for
24 one year, two for two years, two for three years, and two
25 for four years, respectively. The ninth and tenth members
26 appointed shall serve for terms of two and four years,
27 respectively. The eleventh member shall serve for a term
28 of four years. Initial terms date from the first of February
29 immediately preceding appointment. If a vacancy occurs, the

governor shall fill it by appointment for the unexpired term. The appointment shall be submitted to the legislature for confirmation at the next regular or special session.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
