6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a branch of the Alaska
7 Pioneers' Home; providing for a study of the
8 location of a branch; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 47.25.010(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) The state shall maintain an institution for the
13 care of needy persons, [. THE INSTITUTION SHALL BE] known
14 as the Alaska Pioneers' Home. The principal home shall be
15 maintained at Sitka, and a branch may be maintained at a site
16 or sites designated by the governor north and west of
17 Yakutat.

18 * Sec. 2. The Department of Health and Welfare shall make a
19 feasibility study as to the best location for a branch of the
20 Alaska Pioneers' Home, and shall make a report on the feasibility
21 study to the second session of the Third Legislature. No branch
22 of the home may be acquired or operated before the submission of
23 this report.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1963.
