For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to petitions for initiatives
7 or referendums in political subdivisions; and
8 providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 29.65.020 is amended to read:

Sec. 29.65.020. PETITION. Every petition for either

12

the initiative or referendum in the government of a political

13

subdivision shall be signed by a number of qualified voters

14

residing within the territorial limits of the political sub-

15

division equal to (1) if a city or borough of less than

16

7,500 persons, 25 per cent; or (2) if a city or borough of

17

7,500 persons or more, 15 [25] per cent of the total number

18

of votes cast at the next preceding general election in the

19

city or borough concerned or special election called for the

20

purpose of electing city or borough officers, and every

21

petition shall be filed with the chief executive officer of

22

the political subdivision.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

24

and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
