6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring a motor vehicle insurance
7 policy to include a provision insuring
8 against the uninsured motorist; and providing
9 for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 21.10.225 is amended by adding new subsections
12 to read:

13 (b) No motor vehicle insurance policy may be issued,
14 or delivered or renewed in the state under AS 28.20 or under
15 this title unless it includes insurance coverage for in-
16 sured persons under the policy who may be legally entitled
17 to recover damages for bodily injury or death or property
18 as a result of an accident, from the owner or operator of an
19 uninsured motor vehicle.

20 (c) The insurance coverage under (b) of this section
21 may not be less than the amounts or limits prescribed for
22 bodily injury or death or property damage for a motor vehicle
23 insurance policy under the Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility
24 Act (AS 28.20.)

25 (d) A motor vehicle insurance policy is excepted from
26 (b) of this section if the insured has an employee who ex-
27 clusively operates his motor vehicle and the employee is
28 covered under the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act (AS
29 23.20). "Motor vehicle" for the purposes of this paragraph

means a motor vehicle designed or used for moving freight
or property over the highway.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1963.
