IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act raising the minimum salaries of teachers and school administrators; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Sec. 14.20.220 is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 14.20.220. TEACHERS' SALARY SCHEDULE BY SENATE DISTRICT. (a) The school board of each school district in the state shall pay a regularly qualified teacher employed by it a salary not less than that set forth in the following scale:

(1) Southeastern Senate District.

4 (2) Southcentral Senate District. In the South-
5 central Senate District, the amount of \$400 shall be added
6 to each step of the Southeastern Senate District salary
7 scale.

8 (3) Central and Northwest Senate Districts and
9 that part of the Southcentral Senate District lying west of
10 152° West Longitude. In the Central and Northwest Senate
11 Districts and in that part of the Southcentral part of the
12 Southcentral Senate District lying west of 152° West Longi-
13 tude, the amount of \$700 shall be added to each step of the
14 Southeastern Senate District salary scale.

15 (b) The state Department of Education, as the
16 operating agency of schools outside school districts, shall
17 pay a regularly qualified teacher employed by the state a
18 salary not less than \$500 per year above the salary set out
19 in (a) of this section.

20 (c) Not more than four years of public school ex-
21 perience outside the state may be substituted for a like
22 period of public school experience in the state when a
23 teacher's position on the salary scale is established.

24 * Sec. 2. Sec. 14.20.230 is repealed.

25 * Sec. 3. Sec. 14.20.240 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

26 Sec. 14.20.240. SALARY SCALE FOR SUPERINTENDENTS,
27 PRINCIPALS, TEACHING PRINCIPALS, HEAD TEACHERS AND TEACHERS-
28 IN-CHARGE. The school boards of school districts within
29 the state and the state Department of Education as the

1 operating agency for schools outside school districts shall
2 pay regularly qualified superintendents, principals,
3 teaching principals, head teachers and teachers-in-charge
4 a salary which shall be not less than the allowable base
5 salary for the Senate District in which employed, as pro-
6 vided in AS 14.20.220, plus a percentage of that base
7 salary according to the following schedule:

8	Teacher-in-charge	4 per cent
9	Head Teacher	7 per cent
10	Teaching Principal	10 per cent
11	Principal	15 per cent
12	Superintendent	20 per cent

13 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1963.
