6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the penalty for driving  
7 a motor vehicle without the owner's consent."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.35.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person who drives, tows away, or takes a vehicle  
11 not his own without the consent of the owner, with intent  
12 temporarily to deprive the owner of possession of the vehicle,  
13 or a person who is a party or accessory to or an accomplice  
14 in the driving or unauthorized taking is guilty of a felony  
15 [MISDEMEANOR], and upon conviction is punishable by imprison-  
16 ment for not more than two years, [ONE YEAR] or by a fine of  
17 not more than \$2,000, [\$1,000] or by both. The consent of  
18 the owner of a vehicle to its driving, towing away, or taking  
19 shall not be presumed or implied because of the owner's con-  
20 sent on previous occasions to the driving, towing away, or  
21 taking of the vehicle by the same or a different person.
