BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.56.020 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.56.020. ALASKA STATE MORTGAGE ASSOCIATION.

12

There is the Alaska State Mortgage Association. The asso-

13

ciation is a public corporation and government instrument-

14

ality within the Department of Commerce, but having a legal

15

existence independent of and separate from the state, and

16

has continuing succession until its existence is terminated

17

by law. The association may not be terminated as long as

18

it has bonds, notes, and other obligations outstanding.

19

Upon termination of the association, its rights and property

20

pass to the state.

* Sec. 2. AS 44.56 is amended by adding new sections to read:

Sec. 44.56.045. MINUTES OF MEETINGS. The association

23

shall keep minutes of each meeting and send a certified copy

24

to the governor.

25

Sec. 44.56.055. LEGAL ADVISOR. The attorney general

26

is the legal counsel for the association. He shall advise

27

the corporation in legal matters and represent it in suits.

28

Sec. 44.56.093. ANNUAL REPORT. Before December 1 of

29

each year, the association shall submit to the governor and

the legislature a comprehensive report describing the operations, fiscal transactions, financial condition, and future plans of the association. The governor may prescribe the form of the report.

Sec. 44.56.096. ANNUAL AUDIT. The association shall have its financial records audited annually. The legislative auditor shall conduct the annual audit. If an audit conducted by a certified public accountant is satisfactory in the judgment of the legislative auditor, it may be accepted instead of the state audit. The legislative auditor may prescribe the form and contents of the financial records of the association and may have access to these records at any time.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
