RULES COMMITTEE
BY REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR

1 IN THE SENATE

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Rampart Dam Develop-
7 ment Committee; and providing for an effec-
8 tive date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.45 is amended by adding new sections to
11 read:

12 ARTICLE 7.

13 RAMPART DAM DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

14 Sec. 44.45.180. CREATION OF COMMITTEE. There is
15 hereby created a Rampart Dam Development Committee.

16 Sec. 44.45.190. POWERS AND DUTIES. The committee
17 shall:

18 (1) study the feasibility of the Rampart Dam and
19 other dam sites in the Yukon Basin and make reports to the
20 governor and to the people;

21 (2) use every appropriate means to inform the
22 United States Congress and the public, both within and out-
23 side Alaska, of Rampart Dam and Alaska's power and resource
24 potential and how development of this potential would be in
25 the best interest of the people of the United States and the
26 State of Alaska;

27 (3) whenever possible assist all public and pri-
28 vate agencies and organizations planning or encouraging power
29 development on the Yukon River or its basin;

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(4) recommend to the governor action to further these purposes.

Sec. 44.45.200. COMPOSITION OF COMMITTEE. The committee consists of the governor of the state, the Alaska delegation to Congress, and ten citizens of Alaska appointed to give representation on the committee to major groups interested in the economic development of the Yukon Basin and Alaska as a whole. The governor shall appoint a chairman for the committee.

Sec. 44.45.210. TERM OF MEMBERSHIP. The term of office of each member of the Alaska delegation to Congress on the committee is the term of office of his elected position and does not survive his service in the Congress. Other members of the committee are appointed for three year terms, except that initial appointment of committee members shall be as follows: four for three years, three for two years, three for one year.

Sec. 44.45.220. COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS. Members are entitled to reimbursement for travel costs and per diem incurred in the authorized work of the committee as specified by law for state employees and officials.

Sec. 44.45.230. APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND STAFF. The committee may employ an executive director and such minimum secretarial or stenographic staff as appear vitally necessary.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
