6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Rampart Dam Develop-
7 ment Committee; and providing for an effec-
8 tive date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.45 is amended by adding new sections to
11 read:

12 ARTICLE 7

13 RAMPART DAM DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

14 Sec. 44.45.180. CREATION OF COMMITTEE. There is created
15 in the Department of Economic Development and Planning the
16 Rampart Dam Development Committee.

17 Sec. 44.45.190. COMPOSITION AND TERM OF OFFICE. The
18 committee consists of ten citizens of Alaska appointed by the
19 governor to give representation on the committee to major
20 groups interested in the economic development of the Yukon
21 Basin and Alaska as a whole. Members of the committee are
22 appointed for three-year terms, except that initial appoint-
23 ments shall be four for three years, three for two years, and
24 three for one year.

25 Sec. 44.45.200. COMPENSATION AND PER DIEM. Members of
26 the committee serve without compensation but receive the
27 same transportation costs and per diem as state officials and
28 employees.

29 Sec. 44.45.210. QUORUM AND CHAIRMAN. (a) A majority of

the committee constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business of the committee.

(b) The governor shall appoint a chairman for the committee.

Sec. 44.45.220. POWERS AND DUTIES. The committee shall

(1) use every appropriate means to inform the United States Congress and the public, both inside and outside Alaska, of Rampart Dam and Alaska's power and resource potential, and how development of this potential would be in the best interest of the people of the United States and the State of Alaska;

(2) whenever possible assist all public and private agencies and organizations planning or encouraging power development on the Yukon River or its basin; and

(3) recommend to the governor action to further these purposes.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
