6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of certifi-  
7 cates to air taxi operators."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 02.05.080(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Subject to the provisions of (d) of this section,  
11 the commission shall issue a certificate authorizing the  
12 applicant to engage in air commerce as a contract carrier  
13 [OR AIR TAXI OPERATOR], or authorizing the whole or any part  
14 of the operation covered by an application for a certificate  
15 for a contract [CERTIFICATED] carrier,

16 (1) if the commission finds that the applicant is  
17 fit, willing and able to engage in air commerce properly and  
18 to comply with the provisions of this chapter and the rules,  
19 regulations, and requirements of the commission; and

20 (2) if the commission finds that air commerce and  
21 the performance of it by the applicant is required by the  
22 public convenience and necessity and is consistent with the  
23 declaration of policy contained in sec. 10 of this chapter.

25 (d) No certificate may be issued to a person to operate  
26 as a contract carrier [AN AIR CARRIER] unless the applicant  
27 submits evidence, satisfactory to the commission, showing  
28 that it can and will comply with the provisions of the laws  
29 of the United States and the state, and the rules, regula-

tions, and orders respecting safety of operation.

\* Sec. 3. AS 02.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 02.05.085. ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES TO AIR TAXI OPERATORS. (a) Subject to the provisions of (d) of this section, the commission shall issue a certificate authorizing the applicant to engage in air commerce as an air taxi operator if the commission finds that the applicant is fit, willing and able to engage in air commerce properly and to comply with the provisions of this chapter and the rules, regulations, and requirements of the commission.

(b) This section applies to new service applications only, and not to persons qualifying under sec. 50 of this chapter.

(c) If all of the findings required in (a) of this section are not made, then the application shall be denied.

(d) No certificate may be issued to a person to operate as an air taxi operator unless the applicant submits evidence, satisfactory to the commission, that he can and will comply with the provisions of the laws of the United States and the state, and the rules, regulations, and orders respecting safety of operation.
