SENATE BILL NO. 132

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the research and development of the commercial fisheries of the state; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to improve and rehabilitate the commercial fisheries of Alaska, which are of vital importance to the economic well-being of the state, by enabling the state to take maximum advantage of the Federal contributions to research and development proposed to be made under the terms of S. 627 as introduced in the 88th Congress of the United States.

* Sec. 2. The commissioner of fish and game shall immediately prepare a complete plan, including specifications and estimates, for the research and development of the commercial fisheries of the state, in compliance with the intent of S. 627 as introduced in the 88th Congress. He shall so prepare it as to ensure that the state will derive maximum benefit from the funds to be made available by that bill. He shall have the plan ready for presentation to the Secretary of the Interior on July 1, 1963.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
