IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing number of members on
advisory school boards for larger rural
schools."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.10.370 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.10.370. ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY SCHOOL
BOARDS. There is established an advisory school board [OF
THREE MEMBERS] in each community and area served by a rural
school operated by the department. If the rural school has
an average daily enrollment of not more than 250 pupils, the
advisory school board shall consist of three members, and if
the average daily enrollment is more than 250 pupils, the
advisory school board shall consist of five members.

* Sec. 2. AS 14.10.380 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.10.380. TERMS [TERM] OF OFFICES [OFFICE] AND
VACANCIES. (a) The terms of the initial [BOARD] members
of three-member boards are one, two and three years, respec-
tively. Thereafter, board members shall be elected to three-
year terms. [THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL FILL A VACANCY UNTIL
THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION, AT WHICH TIME AN ELECTION WILL BE
HELD FOR THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE TERM.]

(b) Initial members of an advisory school board which
consists of five members when the board is created, are
elected; one to a one-year term, two to a two-year term, and

1 N two to a three-year term. Thereafter, all board members
2 E are elected to three-year terms.

3 W (c) In the event that a three-member board is in-
4 creased to a five-member board because of increased enroll-
5 ment, the two additional members are elected for terms of
6 M three years each.

7 A (d) Vacancies on advisory school boards occurring
8 T between regular elections will be filled by the remaining
9 T board members until the next regular election, at which
10 E time an election will be held for the remaining portion
11 R of the term.
