6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the pay of teachers and  
7 superintendents; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.220 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 14.20.220. MINIMUM TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY  
12 SENATE DISTRICT. (a) The school board of each school dis-  
13 trict in the Southeastern Senate District shall pay a  
14 regularly qualified teacher employed by it a salary not less  
15 than that set out in this subsection.

16 (1) The base salary of a teacher with three years'  
17 training is \$4,850 for a teacher with no public school  
18 experience in the state. This salary is augmented by \$150  
19 for each year of public school experience in the state up to  
20 and including four years.

21 (2) The base salary for a teacher holding a  
22 bachelor's degree and having the requisite number of hours in  
23 education is \$5,700. This salary is augmented by the sum of  
24 .05 times the base for each year of public school experience  
25 in the state up to and including eight years.

26 (3) The base salary for a teacher having a  
27 master's degree and the required number of hours of education  
28 is the base established in (2) of this subsection, plus .10  
29 times the base. The base is augmented by the sum of .05

1 times the base for each year of teaching experience in the  
2 state up to and including 12 years.

3 (b) The school board of each school in the South-  
4 central Senate District shall pay the amount set out in (a)  
5 of this section plus \$400.

6 (c) The school board of each school in the Central and  
7 Northwest Senate Districts and that part of the Southcentral  
8 Senate District lying west of 152° West Longitude shall pay  
9 the amount set out in (a) of this section plus \$700.

10 (d) The department, as the operating agency of schools  
11 outside school districts, shall pay a regularly qualified  
12 teacher employed by the state a salary of not less than  
13 \$500 a year above the salary set out in (a), (b), and (c) of  
14 this section.

15 (e) Not more than four years of public school experi-  
16 ence outside the state may be substituted for a like period  
17 of public school experience in the state when a teacher's  
18 position on the salary scale is established.

20 Sec. 14.20.230. SUPERINTENDENT'S SALARY SCALE BY  
21 SENATE DISTRICT. (a) The school board of each school dis-  
22 trict in the Southeastern Senate District shall pay a regu-  
23 larly qualified superintendent employed by it a salary not  
24 less than that set out in this subsection. The base salary  
25 of a superintendent with no public school experience in the  
26 state is (1) in an 85 per cent school, \$6,500; (2) in an  
27 80 per cent school, \$7,000; and (3) in a 75 per cent school,  
28 \$7,500. This salary is augmented by \$200 for each year of  
29 public school experience in the state up to and including

(b) The school board of each school in the Southcentral Senate District shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this section plus \$500.

(c) The school board of each school in the Central and Northwest Senate Districts and that part of the Southcentral Senate District lying west of 152° West Longitude shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this section plus \$800.

(d) The department, as the operating agency of schools outside school districts, shall pay a regularly qualified superintendent employed by the state a salary not less than \$500 a year above the salary set out in (a), (b), and (c) of this section.

(e) Not more than four years of public school administrative experience outside the state may be substituted for a like period of public school administrative experience in the state when a superintendent's position on the salary scale is established.

Sec. 14.20.240. AMOUNTS ESTABLISHED ABOVE SALARY SCALE FOR PRINCIPALS, VICE PRINCIPALS, HEAD TEACHERS, AND TEACHERS-IN-CHARGE. The school board of each school district in the state, and the department, [STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION] as the operating agency for schools outside school districts, shall pay each regularly qualified principal, vice principal, head teacher, and teacher-in-charge employed by them a salary which is not less than the allowable salary for the senate district in which employed plus a pro rata share of his yearly salary for time which he is required by his contract

to work in addition to normal teacher contract time, plus  
[THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS:]

(1) for a teacher-in-charge, \$400; [TEACHER-IN-CHARGE . . . \$200]

(2) for a head teacher, \$500; [HEAD TEACHER . . . 400]

(3) for a vice principal, \$500; [VICE PRINCIPAL . . . 400]

(4) for a principal, \$1,000. [PRINCIPAL . . . 800]
