5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to members on advisory
7 school boards for state-operated schools."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.10.370 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.10.370. ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY SCHOOL
11 BOARDS. There is established an advisory school board [OF
12 THREE MEMBERS] in each community and area served by a [RURAL]
13 school operated by the department. If the state-operated
14 school has an average daily enrollment of not more than 250
15 pupils, the advisory school board shall consist of three
16 members, and if the average daily enrollment is more than
17 250 pupils, the advisory school board shall consist of five
18 members.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 14.10.380 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 14.10.380. TERMS [TERM] OF OFFICES [OFFICE] AND
21 VACANCIES. (a) The terms of the initial [BOARD] members
22 of three-member boards are one, two and three years, res-
23 pectively. Thereafter, board members shall be elected to
24 three-year terms. [THE BOARD MEMBERS SHALL FILL A
25 VACANCY UNTIL THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION, AT WHICH TIME
26 AN ELECTION WILL BE HELD FOR THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE
27 TERM.]

28 (b) Initial members of an advisory school board which
29 consists of five members when the board is created, are

1 N elected; one to a one-year term, two to a two-year term, and
2 E two to a three-year term. Thereafter, all board members
3 W are elected to three-year terms.

4 (c) In the event that a three-member board is in-
5 creased to a five-member board because of increased enroll-
6 ment, the two additional members are elected for terms of
7 M three years each.

8 A (d) Vacancies on advisory school boards occurring
9 T between regular elections will be filled by the remaining
10 T board members until the next regular election, at which
11 E time an election will be held for the remaining portion
12 R of the term.

14 Sec. 14.10.375. QUALIFICATIONS OF ADVISORY SCHOOL
15 BOARD MEMBERS. A person may be elected to membership on an
16 advisory school board who

- 17 (1) is a citizen of the United States;
18 (2) has passed his 19th birthday;
19 (3) is an inhabitant of the area served by the
20 school.

21 Sec. 14.10.395. VOTER QUALIFICATIONS. A person may
22 vote at any election for advisory school board members who

- 23 (1) is a citizen of the United States;
24 (2) has passed his 19th birthday;
25 (3) is an inhabitant of the area served by the
26 school at the time of the election;
27 (4) if the school is an on-base school, is a
28 parent of a child enrolled in the school at the time of the
29 election.
