IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

THIRD LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the rank of assistant adjutants general in the Alaska National Guard; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 26.05.180 is amended to read:

Sec. 26.05.180. HEADQUARTERS STAFF OF ALASKA NATIONAL GUARD. The adjutant general shall have a headquarters staff consisting of not more than two assistant adjutants general, who are authorized to have the rank of brigadier general, and other necessary officers, clerks and employees required to conduct properly the operation of the Department of Military Affairs. The staff is appointed by and is subject to removal by the adjutant general. Their salaries are payable out of state funds. There shall also be appointed such staff officers of the Alaska National Guard as may be prescribed by the laws of the United States and the regulations of the Defense Department to complete the organization of the headquarters. Assistant adjutants general for the Army National Guard of Alaska and the Air National Guard are appointed by the adjutant general with the rank and qualifications he prescribes.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
