6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the maintenance and
7 operation of certain machines and
8 mechanical devices; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 11.60 is amended by adding new sections to
12 read:

13 Sec. 11.60.175. CERTAIN DEVICES PERMITTED. Notwith-
14 standing any other provision of this chapter, it is lawful
15 for any person to own, buy, sell, operate, lease or possess,
16 or to permit to be placed in any building owned, leased or
17 occupied by him, or to operate or facilitate the operation
18 of, whether as owner, agent or servant, whether for hire
19 or not, or for any person to use or participate in the use
20 of any machine or mechanical device which may or may not
21 register free plays and may or may not permit the playing
22 of additional games if properly licensed or taxed and such
23 devices shall be exempt from any laws prohibiting their
24 transportation.

25 Sec. 11.60.177. TRANSFER OF PLAYS. It is lawful to
26 transfer manually free plays or games registered on any
27 device described in sec. 175 of this chapter, from one such
28 device to another at the same location.

29 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
