6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting recovery from an owner or
7 operator of a motor vehicle by his guest or
8 licensee in the event of an accident involv-
9 ing the motor vehicle; excepting certain
10 cases."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to
13 read:

14 Sec. 28.35.270. GUEST OR LICENSEE OF OWNER OR OPERATOR
15 OF MOTOR VEHICLE PROHIBITED FROM RECOVERY IN THE EVENT OF
16 ACCIDENT. (a) No guest or licensee transported without pay-
17 ment by the owner or operator of a motor vehicle has a cause
18 of action for damages against the owner or operator for in-
19 juries, death, or loss, if an accident occurs, unless (1)
20 the accident was intentional on the part of the owner or
21 operator; or (2) the accident was caused by the owner's or
22 operator's gross negligence or intoxication.

23 (b) This section does not relieve an owner or operator
24 of a motor vehicle from liability if the vehicle is being
25 demonstrated to a prospective purchaser.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act does not affect in any way those causes of
27 action which arise before the effective date of this Act, or the
28 trial of them.
