6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making kindergartens of public
7 schools eligible for Public School Founda-
8 tion Program aid; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 14.17.050 is amended by adding a new paragraph
12 to read:

13 (1) To figure average daily membership for an elemen-
14 tary school with a kindergarten, count two kindergarten
15 pupils as one pupil.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.250(4) is amended to read:

17 (4) "elementary school" means a school consisting
18 of grades one through eight, kindergarten through eight, or
19 an appropriate combination of grades within this range;

20 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
21 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
