BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding new sections to

ARTICLE 5. TAKING FISH NOT FOR SALE OR BARTER

13

Sec. 16.05.740. AUTHORIZED TAKING. A person may, with-  
out a license, take fish to feed himself, those dependent on  
him, and his animals.

Sec. 16.05.750. LIMITATIONS. (a) The board, by regu-  
lation, may

(1) limit the times and places that fish may be

19

taken and the kinds and number of fish that may be taken

20

under sec. 740 of this chapter;

21

(2) limit the types of gear that may be used to

22

take fish under sec. 740 of this chapter;

23

(3) require a person to obtain a permit, issued to

24

all applicants without charge, in areas in which permits will

25

help to prevent the unauthorized taking of fish without a

26

license.

(b) A person who takes fish under sec. 740 of this

28

chapter may not sell or barter away the fish unless the

29

board permits the fish to be bartered. The board, by

1 regulation, may permit the fish to be bartered in areas in  
2 which to do so will not jeopardize proper conservation.

5 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
