6 For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting practicing dentists from
7 jury duty."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 09.20.030 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 09.20.030. EXEMPTIONS. A person may claim exemp-
11 tion and may be excused from service as a juror if it be
12 shown that jury service will cause him to suffer material
13 injury or destruction to his property or to the property en-
14 trusted to him, or if his health, the health or proper care
15 of his family, or the sickness or death of a member of his
16 family makes it necessary for him to be excused, or if he is

17 (1) a judicial officer;

18 (2) any other civil officer of the state or
19 United States whose duties are at the time inconsistent with
20 his attendance or service as a juror;

21 (3) an attorney;

22 (4) a minister of the gospel or priest of any
23 denomination;

24 (5) a teacher in a university, college, academy,
25 or school;

26 (6) a practicing physician; [.]

27 (7) a practicing dentist.
