Sec. 14.40.700. LIMITATION ON USE OF UNIVERSITY AND
COLLEGE FACILITIES BY CERTAIN PERSONS. (a) The governing
body of a college or university receiving state aid shall
forbid the use of school facilities for any political acti-
vity to any member of an organization required to be
registered with the Attorney General of the United States
under 18 USC sec. 2386.

(b) A college or university the governing body of
which knowingly permits the use of facilities contrary to
(a) of this section becomes ineligible for further state aid
from that date until the Board of Education certifies to the
governor that it is satisfied that such an occurrence is not
likely to be repeated.

(c) As used in (a) of this section, "political acti-
vity" means an activity the purpose or aim of which, or one
of the purposes or aims of which, is the control by force or
overthrow of the government of the United States or a
