For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting unauthorized use of the
7 emblem or slogan of the Alaska Centennial
8 Commission; prohibiting unauthorized repre-
9 sentations of connection with the Alaska
10 Centennial Commission; and providing for an
11 effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. (a) No person may use, display, or publish the
14 slogan or emblem of the Alaska Centennial Commission for commercial
15 purposes or private gain without the written authorization of that
16 commission.

(b) No person may use, display, or publish any name, title,
18 or device that tends to indicate that he is affiliated with or
19 supported or sponsored by the Alaska Centennial Commission without
20 the written authorization of that commission.

21

(c) A person who violates this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor
22 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.
23 Each day of unauthorized use, display, or publication constitutes
24 a separate offense.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
26 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
