6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to election of the Board  
7 of Governors of the Alaska Bar."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.08.050(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Three members of the board shall be elected from  
11 the first judicial district, three members of the board from  
12 the third judicial district, two members from the fourth  
13 judicial district, and one member from the second judicial  
14 district [THREE MEMBERS FROM THE COMBINED AREA OF THE SECOND  
15 AND FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICTS. NO MORE THAN TWO MEMBERS  
16 MAY BE RESIDENT PRACTICING ATTORNEYS IN THE FOURTH JUDICIAL  
17 DISTRICT WHEN THERE ARE FOUR OR MORE RESIDENT PRACTICING  
18 ATTORNEYS IN THE SECOND DISTRICT].

20 (c) Three board members shall be elected annually,  
21 one from the first judicial district, one from the third  
22 judicial district and one from the second or fourth judicial  
23 districts [EACH AREA DESCRIBED IN (A) OF THIS SECTION].
