6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a serviceman's hunting
7 and fishing licenses."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a)(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) Resident sport fishing license \$5

11 However, a serviceman who has been stationed in Alaska for
12 30 days on other than temporary duty but has not fulfilled
13 the residence requirements of AS 16.05.940(14) shall be
14 entitled to receive a resident sport fishing license.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.340(a) is amended by adding a new para-
16 graph to read:

17 (17) Serviceman's restricted hunting
18 license \$7

19 A serviceman who has been stationed in Alaska for 30 days on
20 other than temporary duty but has not fulfilled the require-
21 ments of AS 16.05.940(14) for a resident hunting license,
22 may purchase a serviceman's restricted hunting license in
23 lieu of a nonresident hunting license. No serviceman shall
24 be permitted to take brown or grizzly bear, black bear,
25 polar bear, deer, bison, moose, sheep, walrus, elk, goats
26 or caribou under a serviceman's restricted hunting license
27 unless he first obtains an appropriate nonresident big game
28 tag as provided in (16) of this section.
