6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle registra-
7 tion plates; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.10.120 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 28.10.120. ISSUANCE OF PLATES UPON REGISTRATION.

12 (a) When the department registers a vehicle, it shall issue
13 to the owner one registration plate and one validation
14 sticker for a motorcycle, trailer, or semi-trailer, and two
15 registration plates and two validation stickers for every
16 other motor vehicle. The plates shall be issued to the
17 vehicle registered and shall not be removed from it during
18 the term for which the plates are issued and shall not be
19 used upon another vehicle, except as otherwise provided in
20 this chapter. The validation stickers shall be placed on the
21 plates in the upper right-hand corner and shall not be re-
22 moved from them during the term for which the stickers are
23 issued.

24 (b) Every registration plate shall have displayed on it
25 the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it
26 is issued and [,] the name of this state [, AND THE YEAR FOR
27 WHICH THE PLATE IS ISSUED]. The sticker shall show the year
28 for which it is issued. The first number of the registration
29 number is the election district in which it is issued.

1 Special plates for mobile amateur radio stations shall have
2 the Federal Communications Commission call letters of the
3 owner displayed on them in place of the registration number.

4 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 28.10.129. REFLECTING PLATES. Each plate and
6 validation sticker is coated with material that reflects
7 substantially more light at night than automobile finishes
8 usually do.

9 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.170 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 28.10.170. EXPIRATION OF REGISTRATION. Every
11 vehicle registration, every registration card, and every
12 validation sticker [REGISTRATION PLATE] issued under this
13 chapter expire at midnight on March 1 of each year. Every
14 registration plate expires on March 1 five years after the
15 year it is issued. The owner of a registered vehicle may
16 operate the vehicle under the registration for the preceding
17 year upon displaying the validation sticker [REGISTRATION
18 PLATES] issued for that year until May 31 of the year for
19 which the registration is required.

20 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.130 is repealed.

21 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 1965.
