6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for immunity from suit
7 for real estate owners who permit their
8 premises to be used to shelter persons
9 during an actual or practice attack."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 26.20 is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 Sec. 26.20.145. IMMUNITY FROM SUIT. A person owning
14 or controlling real estate who voluntarily and without
15 compensation permits the designation or use of the whole or
16 part of his real estate for the purposes of sheltering per-
17 sons during an actual or practice attack shall, together
18 with his successors in interest, be immune from suit for
19 negligence arising out of the construction or maintenance
20 of the property causing the death of, or injury to, any
21 person using the shelter during an actual or practice attack.
