6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating money for the repay-
7 ment of fines paid by certain persons con-
8 victed of alleged violations of the Alaska
9 Fish and Game Code; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. The purpose of this Act is to reimburse the per-
13 sons named in this bill for the fines paid to the state upon their
14 conviction in the district magistrate court at Seward for alleged
15 violations of a regulation promulgated under the Fish and Game
16 Code, AS 16.05, when, owing to the fact that the sign which indi-
17 cated that a portion of a stream was closed to fishing had been
18 removed, the persons convicted could not have known that the acts
19 complained of were in violation of the law.

20 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$610 is appropriated to the following
21 persons in the amounts shown for the purpose set forth in sec. 1
22 of this Act:
