5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act modifying the distance from a
7 college or university beyond which liquor
8 may be sold."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.15.020(e) is repealed and re-enacted to
11 read:

12 (e) Churches and schools. The board shall not issue
13 a beverage dispensary license or package liquor store
14 license for the sale of any intoxicating liquor in any
15 building within 200 feet measured by the shortest direct line
16 from the grounds of a school, from an accredited college or
17 university certified by Northwest Association for the Accred-
18 iting of Institutions of Formal Education or from a church
19 building in which religious services are conducted, within
20 or without any corporate municipality. A license may be
21 reissued or transferred from one licensee to another, for
22 the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building in which that
23 sale was authorized by law on April 25, 1960. When a license
24 for the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building within 200
25 feet of the grounds of a school, college or university, or
26 church building in which religious services are conducted is
27 forfeited, lapses or is transferred to other premises, no
28 license for the sale of intoxicating liquor at the prior
29 licensed location shall thereafter be issued. However, the

the cause of the restriction.
