6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting aliens not lawfully
7 admitted to the United States from fishing
8 commercially in Alaska territorial waters;
9 and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 Sec. 16.05.905. ALIEN FISHING PROHIBITED. Alien per-
14 sons not lawfully admitted to the United States are pro-
15 hibited from engaging in commercial fishing activities in
16 the territorial waters of the State of Alaska as they
17 presently exist or may be extended in the future.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

19 Sec. 16.05.910. PENALTY. Any alien person who vio-
20 lates sec. 905 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon convic-
21 tion is punishable by a fine of not more than \$10,000 or
22 by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both.

23 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
24 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
