6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to transfer of civil de-  
7 fense property to political subdivisions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 44.74 is amended by adding a new section to  
10 read:

11 Sec. 44.74.090. TRANSFER OF CIVIL DEFENSE PROPERTY.

12 (a) Title to personal property received by the state from  
13 the federal government for civil defense purposes may be  
14 transferred to political subdivisions of the state which  
15 have qualified civil defense organizations by the Department  
16 of Public Safety with the approval of the state director of  
17 civil defense and the approval of the Department of Adminis-  
18 tration. This section is applicable only when title to the  
19 property is held by the Department of Public Safety.

20 (b) As a condition of title transfer, the political  
21 subdivision is responsible for compliance with the federal  
22 and state restrictions on the property.

23 (c) No transfer of title to property shall be made  
24 which is not in compliance with federal law and with the  
25 terms of the agreement under which the property has been  
26 made available to the state by the federal government.
