6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the prohibition of  
7 employment of persons not citizens."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.05.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 39.05.010. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS  
11 PROHIBITED. (a) It is unlawful for the state or a munici-  
12 pality in the state to employ as an officer, agent or  
13 servant, a person who is not a citizen of the United States,  
14 unless qualified citizens of the United States are not  
15 available. No non-citizen shall be employed unless he has  
16 filed a declaration of intention to become a United States  
17 citizen, expresses the intention to become a resident of  
18 Alaska and takes the oath prescribed in sec. 130 of this  
19 chapter.

20 (b) This section does not apply to persons employed  
21 on an emergency basis or temporarily employed or employed  
22 while within the state under a foreign exchange program.
