6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the attorney general to
7 aid recipients of Workmen's Compensation to
8 collect defaulted Workmen's Compensation
9 payments."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 23.30.170(b) is amended to read:

12 (b) If the payment in default is an installment of the
13 award, the board may, in its discretion, declare the whole of
14 the award, as the amount in default. The applicant may file
15 a certified copy of the supplementary order with the clerk
16 of the superior court. The supplementary order is final.
17 The court shall, upon the filing of the copy, enter judgment
18 for the amount declared in default by the supplementary order
19 if it is in accordance with law. When a judgment of default
20 is entered by the superior court, the attorney general, when
21 requested to do so by the commissioner, shall take appropri-
22 ate action to assure collection of the defaulted payments.
