6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the attorney general to
7 aid recipients of Workmen's Compensation to
8 collect defaulted Workmen's Compensation
9 payments."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 23.30.170(b) is amended to read:

12 (b) If the payment in default is an installment of the
13 award, the board may, in its discretion, declare the whole
14 of the award, as the amount in default. The applicant may
15 file a certified copy of the supplementary order with the
16 clerk of the superior court. The supplementary order is
17 final. The court shall, upon the filing of the copy, enter
18 judgment for the amount declared in default by the supple-
19 mentary order if it is in accordance with law. When a
20 judgment of default is entered by the superior court, the
21 attorney general, when requested to do so by the commissioner,
22 shall take appropriate action to assure collection of the
23 defaulted payments.
