6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of the  
7 justices of the supreme court and the  
8 judges of the superior court; and providing  
9 for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) The chief justice shall receive \$24,500 [\$23,500]  
13 annually, and each associate justice shall receive \$23,500  
14 [\$22,500] annually as compensation. The compensation is pay-  
15 able monthly in 12 equal installments. Compensation of the  
16 chief justice or of an associate justice shall not be  
17 diminished during his term of office, unless by general law  
18 applying to all salaried officers of the state.

19 \* Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$20,000  
21 [\$19,000] annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12  
22 equal installments. The compensation of a judge shall not  
23 be diminished during his term of office, unless by general  
24 law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

25 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1964.
