6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the hiring of state  
7 employees; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 39 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

11 CHAPTER 40

12 ARTICLE 1.

13 Sec. 39.40.010. STATE EMPLOYMENT SERVICE TO BE USED  
14 WHERE POSSIBLE. In hiring employees, whether on a full-time,  
15 part-time, permanent or temporary basis, each department and  
16 agency of the state shall use the free public employment  
17 services of the state employment service and wherever possible  
18 shall give priority in employment to qualified applicants  
19 registered with the service. The commissioner of labor shall  
20 provide appropriate cooperation and assistance to all depart-  
21 ments and agencies of the state in implementing the policy  
22 of this section.

23 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
24 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
