6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of limited  
7 motor vehicle operators' licenses; and pro-  
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 28.15 is amended by adding a new section to  
11 read:

12 Sec. 28.15.229. REQUEST FOR ISSUANCE OF LIMITED LICENSE  
13 IN CERTAIN CASES. (a) A person whose license is in a con-  
14 dition of suspension or revocation on the effective date of  
15 this section may request the district magistrate court to  
16 review the facts of suspension or revocation and to instruct  
17 the department to issue him a limited license.

18 (b) If the court finds that the ability of the person  
19 making the request to earn a livelihood is severely impaired,  
20 and that a limitation can be placed on the license which will  
21 enable the person to earn a livelihood without excessive risk  
22 of danger to the public, the court shall instruct the depart-  
23 ment to issue a limited license to the applicant. The depart-  
24 ment shall issue a limited license as in other cases.
