6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to vessel licenses; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.490 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.490. VESSEL LICENSE. (a) As a condition
11 to the delivery or landing of fish or engaging in commercial
12 fishing within the state, a license is required for a
13 commercial vessel, including a vessel used in charter ser-
14 vice for the recreational taking of fish and shellfish.
15 The license shall be issued to the owner of the vessel and
16 the residency or non-residency of the owner shall determine
17 the type of license issued. The owner need not be present
18 on the vessel when the vessel is engaged in commercial
19 fishing activity.

20 (b) Upon sale of the vessel, the vessel license shall
21 be transferred to the new owner.

22 (c) A licensee, or his legal representative, shall
23 give notice of the transfer to the nearest department office
24 before the transferee starts commercial fishing operations
25 with the vessel.

26 The notice shall contain:

27 (1) the number of the vessel license and the
28 Department of Fish and Game vessel number;

29 (2) the name and address of the person to whom

the license is transferred.
